Code of Conduct SDHXCS strives to maintain a safe and orderly environment. Students are expected to follow the Code:

- Be responsible for their actions.
- Follow directions the first time they are given.
- Be ready to work when class begins.
- Bring all study tools.
- Be polite and respectful in word and action.
- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Be actively involved in class and school activities.
- Keep hands, feet and objects to themselves.

Standard of Conduct

1. **Be on time.** Late arrival or early retrieve interrupt teachings.

Class schedule:

- Regular Program: morning session 9:30am-11:20am Chinese
 afternoon session 1:30pm-3:20pm Chinese
 weekday session 7:00pm-8:00pm Chinese
 (Weekday is for Bilingual Only)

- Credit Program: morning session 9:30am-1:00pm Chinese
 afternoon session 1:30pm-5:00pm Chinese
 weekday session 5:30pm-9:00pm Chinese
 (Weekday is for credit level TBD)

- Math Program: noon session 11:30am-12:30pm Math

- Enrichment Program: morning session 11:30am-12:30pm
 afternoon session 3:30pm-4:30pm
 more sessions TBD

2. **Truancy** is not acceptable. The teachers must be notified ahead of time in case a schedule conflict or illness. Student must complete and turn in missed works upon returning to the class.

- Two or more absences without notification to the teacher or to the Administration will be considered as "Withdraw Voluntarily", student can be suspended for the rest of the school year.
 - No refund will be granted.
3. **Be seated at the seat assigned** by the teacher. Students are responsible for the conditions of the desks and chairs they are assigned to.
 4. **Electronic devices** (such as cell phone, iPad, iTouch, Nintendo, etc.) are not permitted to use during teaching period, unless it is for teaching purpose and with the teacher's consent.
 - Violation of the policy can result in confiscation of the item by the teacher.
 - The confiscated item will be held in the Administration office, and it may be returned only to the parents/guardian of the student.
 - The school is not responsible for lost or stolen of these items.
 5. No food or drink (except bottled water) are allowed in the classrooms. Keep classrooms, hallway and restrooms clean and tidy.
 6. Chewing gum is prohibited on campus.
 7. Do not play in the restroom or elevator.
 8. Do not climb furniture, wall or trees, or slide on handrail of the stairs.
 9. Skate boarding is prohibited on campus.
 10. Hazardous items (such as sharp scissors, knife, gun, explosives, rope, etc.) are strictly PROHIBITED on campus.
 11. Do not throw any object, it can hurt unexpected people.
 12. Students may not stay inside the classroom without an adult supervision.
 13. Absolutely no play with AV equipment in the classroom. The student will be fully responsible for any damage.

14. No running inside the building. Keep voice low so others are not disturbed.
15. Do not play with or remove any equipment or furniture from the classrooms. These are properties of Miramar College.
16. When class is in session, reading or talking about stuffs unrelated to the teaching content are not desired.
17. Do not leave the classroom or campus without the teacher's or parent's consent.
18. Bully is absolutely not tolerated. Disciplinary actions may include but not limited to suspension or expulsion.
19. Cheating in any form is *Never* tolerated. All parties involved will result in zero credit. We believe honesty and integrity are fundamental components of students' educational experience.
20. Zero tolerance for drugs. Parents will be called, and students will be expelled immediately.

Classroom Expectations:

In addition to the Code of Conduct, teachers may have their own classroom disciplinary plan which must be equally expected by students. If a student chooses not to follow the code and break a rule, disciplinary action will take place.

Absence

- Inform the teacher ahead of time via email. Students are responsible to find out assignments. All works are due upon returning to the class.
- Credit class students please refer to *Credit Program Guidelines*.

Discipline

- Verbal warning: first offense, no body injury or property damage occur.
- Written warning: second offense, or body injury/ property damage occur.
- Suspension: multiple violations, interruption of class order. Parent is required to accompany the student to class.
- Expulsion: Serious offenses, including but not limited to: body injury, property damage, weapons, drug. No tuition refund under such circumstance.

- The student and his/her parents/guardians are held financially responsible for body/emotional injuries and property damage to all parties including the affected fellow student(s), teacher(s) and staff(s), the school, and Miramar College.

Grading System

- Teachers report grades to students/parents twice a year, at the end of each semester.
- Credit class students refer to *Credit Program Guidelines*.
